

# “Christmas Vacation”

December 7, 2024  
4:30 p.m. – Lawrenceburg, KY.

It's once again time to ring in the holiday season with our annual Christmas Parade in the historic downtown Lawrenceburg business district.

All participants are required to fill out a registration and liability form to be eligible to participate in the parade. They must be returned in advance to the address listed below by close of business on November 27<sup>th</sup>.

**No forms will be accepted at the time of line up for the parade and you will not be allowed to participate. Deadline is November 27<sup>th</sup>!**

**COST:** No entry fee, but all entries must complete a registration form and waiver. This must be turned in by November 27<sup>th</sup> or you will not be allowed to participate..

**REGISTRATION:** Registration forms are available via our Web site at [www.lawrenceburgky.org](http://www.lawrenceburgky.org) or in the foyer at City Hall, located at 100 N. Main Street. All participants are required to fill out a registration and liability form to be eligible to participate in the parade. **SANTA AND MRS. CLAUS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE COMMITTEE. NO OTHER ENTRIES WITH SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

**PARADE LINE UP & ROUTE:** The parade will be staged in the Anderson County Community Park area. All entries must enter from US 127. The parade will travel south across Saffell Street; east on Broadway to Main Street, North on Main Street through downtown and finish at the entrance of Mustang Trail. It's a FIRST COME, FIRST IN LINE this year. The park will be available for preparing your entry beginning at 2:30 p.m. **DO NOT SHOW UP EARLY AND BLOCK THE AREA! Reference the number you were given for check-in and share this number with everyone in your group. Only numbers will be used for check-in! No Group or Organization Names.**

**JUDGING:** Judging will take place at 4:00 p.m. at the County Park. You must be in line to be considered for judging. Entries are encouraged to incorporate the theme into their design if possible. Classic car entries and pageant winners will not be judged.

Award recognitions will be given for the first, second and third place in each category. Winners will be provided a sign to place on their entry to be displayed during the parade route.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Horses welcome, coggins required.
- *Entries with animals must provide their own clean up during line up and along the parade route.*
- All riders must be dropped off no later than 3:45 p.m. NO vehicles or entries will be allowed access to the Middle School after 3:45 p.m.
- **NO ITEMS, INCLUDING CANDY, MAY BE THROWN FROM VEHICLE, FLOATS OR OTHER MEANS.** Items may be handed to the crowd only.  
*Please note: If an entry chooses to throw candy, they will be asked to exit the parade immediately and will not be allowed to participate in future events.*
- Any person(s) who will be 6 feet or higher from the ground must have fall protection. Total height for entire float cannot exceed 12 feet.
- Each float must have a spotter (someone other than the driver) in the vehicle pulling the float. Walking spotters are recommended but not required.
- Children 12 and under must be supervised and accompanied by an adult.
- Reference the number you were given for check-in and share this number with everyone in your group. No Group or Organization Names. Only numbers will be used for check-in!
- **SANTA AND MRS. CLAUS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE PARADE COMMITTEE. ALL OTHER ENTRIES ARE NOT TO INCLUDE SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS ON THEIR ENTRIES.**

For the safety of all parade participants, at the discretion of the parade committee any and all entries may be inspected prior to the start of the parade.

**SAFETY AND EMERGENCY:** A public safety station will be set up prior and during the parade for those who may need assistance, first aid or emergency care. You may ask assistance of anyone who will be wearing a lime green vest. These individuals will be serving as safety volunteers and can assist as needed.

**No forms will be accepted at the time of line up for the parade and you will not be allowed to participate. Deadline to turn in forms is November 27<sup>th</sup>!**
