

# “A Kentucky Christmas”

December 6, 2025  
5:00 p.m. – Lawrenceburg, KY

It's once again time to ring in the holiday season with our annual Christmas Parade in the historic downtown Lawrenceburg business district.

All participants are required to fill out a registration and liability form to be eligible to participate in the parade. They must be returned in advance to the address listed below by close of business on **November 26<sup>th</sup>**.

**No forms will be accepted at the time of line up for the parade  
and you will not be allowed to participate.  
Deadline is November 26<sup>th</sup>!**

**COST:** No entry fee, but all entries must complete a registration form and waiver. This must be turned in by November 26<sup>th</sup> or you will not be allowed to participate..

**REGISTRATION:** Registration forms are available via our Web site at [www.lawrenceburgky.org](http://www.lawrenceburgky.org) or in the foyer at City Hall, located at 100 N. Main Street. All participants are required to fill out a registration and liability form to be eligible to participate in the parade. **SANTA AND MRS. CLAUS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE COMMITTEE. NO OTHER ENTRIES WITH SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

**PARADE LINE UP & ROUTE:** The parade will be staged in the Anderson County Community Park area. Parade floats only must enter from US 127. The parade will travel out of the entrance of Mustang Trail heading south on North Main; west on Glensboro Rd; south at Saffell Street; east on Broadway to Main Street; north on Main Street through downtown and finish at the entrance of Mustang Trail.

## **NO GAPS!**

If you cause a delay in the parade, you will be instructed to **speed up immediately or exit the parade.**

## Parade Entry and Parking Instructions

All parade participants are advised to adhere to the following entry and parking procedures:

- **Parade Float Entry:**  
Parade floats will be permitted to enter **only from Highway 127**. Please refer to the attached map for detailed entry directions.
- **Parking and Participant Drop-Off:**  
Parking and drop-off for float participants will be available **exclusively at the Middle School**. Locations are identified on the attached map.
- **Horse and Tractor Staging:**  
Horses and tractors will **stage in their customary location within the county park**. Please see the attached map for reference.

We appreciate your cooperation in following these guidelines to ensure a safe and efficient parade lineup.

 **PARADE LINEUP INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE READ!** 

★ **FIRST COME, FIRST IN LINE!**

- The park opens at 2:30 p.m. for lineup prep.
- ⊘ Do NOT arrive early — early arrivals block the area and delay setup.

 **Check-In Process:**

- Use the number you were assigned — **only numbers** will be used at check-in.
- **Share your number** with everyone in your group.
  - When multiple names are used, it slows down registration.
- If your group arrives separately, **communicate with each other!** We recommend carpooling to lessen the numbers of vehicles.
  - Check-in staff **will not know** where you are in line.
  - Lack of coordination **backs up the process** for everyone.

 Let's work together to keep things smooth, organized, and fun for all participants!

**JUDGING:** Judging will take place during the parade. Entries are encouraged to incorporate the theme into their design if possible. Winners will be announced on the City's social media on Monday, December 8<sup>th</sup>. Award recognitions will be given for the first, second and third place in each category. Classic car entries and pageant winners will not be judged.



## RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Horses welcome, coggins required.
- *Entries with animals must provide their own clean up during line up and along the parade route.*
- All riders must be dropped off no later than 3:45 p.m. **NO vehicles or entries will be allowed access to the drop-off area at the Middle School after 3:45 p.m.**

### IMPORTANT PARADE RULE!

- No items — including candy — may be thrown from vehicles, floats, or any other moving entry.  
☒ You may hand items directly to the crowd only.
- This rule keeps everyone safe and helps us ensure a fun, injury-free parade for all! 🎉

*Please note: If an entry chooses to throw candy, they will be asked to exit the parade immediately and will not be allowed to participate in future events.*

- Any person(s) who will be 6 feet or higher from the ground must have fall protection. Total height for entire float cannot exceed 12 feet.
- Each float must have a spotter (someone other than the driver) in the vehicle pulling the float. Walking spotters are recommended but not required.
- Children 12 and under must be supervised and accompanied by an adult.
- Reference the number you were given for check-in and share this number with everyone in your group. It backs up registration when your group is referenced by 5 different names. Only numbers will be used for check-in!
- **SANTA AND MRS. CLAUS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE PARADE COMMITTEE. ALL OTHER ENTRIES ARE NOT TO INCLUDE SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS ON THEIR ENTRIES.**

For the safety of all parade participants, at the discretion of the parade committee any and all entries may be inspected prior to the start of the parade.

**SAFETY AND EMERGENCY:** A public safety station will be set up prior and during the parade for those who may need assistance, first aid or emergency care. You may ask assistance of anyone who will be wearing a lime green vest. These individuals will be serving as safety volunteers and can assist as needed.

#### **Important Parade Reminder!**

No forms will be accepted **at the time of lineup** for the parade — you **will not be allowed to participate** without prior submission.



**Deadline to turn in forms: November 26th! No exceptions!**
